Westbrook is well known for its deep music roots. It is the birthplace to world famous music luminaries Rudy Vallee and Al Hawks. To honor this rich music history, Discover Downtown Westbrook, in partnership with the City of Westbrook, launched the Vallee Square Concert series in summer 2020. Since its inception, the concert series has attracted thousands of people from Westbrook and beyond.

Seven concerts are scheduled on Thursday evenings in July and August. Partnerships with local high schools and music schools provide young musicians to open the evenings with their performances at 6:30.

Vallee Square sits at the top of the scenic Westbrook Riverwalk. The concert series offers space for seating, bar, and a bike valet. The venue is nestled in the heart of downtown Westbrook within walking distance to a number of restaurants and shops.

The Run the River 5K is a race along a scenic route that starts at Riverbank Park and follows the Presumpscot River, winding through picturesque downtown Westbrook. This event continues to grow in popularity, attracting runners, fitness and outdoor enthusiasts from throughout the eastern US and even Canada.

Runners enjoy taking in the scenes of natural and cultural beauty along the race route, such as views of Westbrook's renowned Saccarappa Falls, architectural marvels in old Frenchtown, and sites in the nationally recognized Cumberland Mills Historic District.

After the race, runners can treat themselves to a great meal and/or drink at any number of downtown Westbrook's acclaimed restaurants and breweries.

Placemaking is the art of creating community in public places. Its roots were born during Urban renewal when buildings were being torn down for being old. There became a groundswell of support to save historic buildings, downtowns and to further design cities for people, not for cars. Placemaking creates and programs community places and spaces by and for the community.

Westbrook Common is pocket park in the heart of the downtown and an ideal location for a placemaking project. In this space, DDW advocates for art installations and hosts programs such as live music, bike rides, markets, dance, fitness, art classes and more. We partner with Westbrook Public Schools to offer free summer lunches, Walker Memorial Library to host story hours, and Westbrook Safe Mobility and Access Committee to host local bike rides around Westbrook.

This year our goals are to introduce new audiences to Westbrook Common, use it in new ways, and expand our promotional strategies.
